Diana's past becomes Saelihn's map.

Diana's disappearance from Jago leads her to Lidium, where she creates a life far from the kingdom she knew. Her history, grief, and unfinished duty become the emotional foundation of Saelihn's journey.



The mother-daughter thread gives the series its heart: inherited responsibility without inherited surrender.

JAGO

The kingdom, the legacy, and the source of political tension.

PARTHON

A dry planet of reptilian trade cities, mercenaries, thieves, and Lord Silas.

OBLAK

A strange planet of tall grassy mountains and altered gravity.

LIDIUM

A dark, crystal-lit planet of sand, islands, treetop homes, and hidden history.

VURR

A fire-connected world tied to Ash and elemental passage.

SEA OF ZAR

A lost aquatic kingdom and a reminder that every world has buried wounds.



Lidium

A sea of sand. Grassy islands. Treetop homes. Giant yellow crystals rising into the sky. One dangerous ocean. A people powered by light and shaken by old corruption.



Lidium lets the story feel both alien and intimate: a beautiful home that can become a battleground.

The stones are not prizes. They are responsibilities.

The Jewels of Jago are tied to restoration, balance, travel, and power. In the wrong hands, they become instruments of control. In Saelihn's hands, they test whether strength can protect without becoming conquest.

ENERGY

Manipulation, speed, force, and fusion light.

OBELISKS

Ancient gateways connecting planets and quests.

STONES

Sources of life, memory, power, and moral testing.

Delany's shadow reaches across worlds.

The central threat is not only a villain chasing power. It is a fractured legacy: kingdoms, families, and planets forced to decide whether power should be inherited, earned, shared, or taken.

The strongest version of the conflict is personal: Saelihn is not fighting a monster. She is fighting what her bloodline could become.

and dangerous.

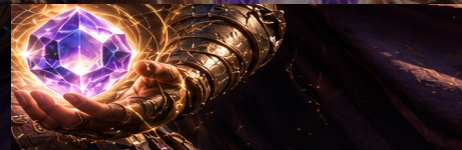
The action vocabulary is built from energy blasts,
